Guidelines

Historic Yellow Springs is honored to have Brett Thomas with Mobileraku at Chester Springs Studio for the Raku Firing Workshop. Please follow these guidelines for the most successful firing experience. If you have any questions email cpizzi@yellowsprings.org.

Pottery:

- Bring up to five bisque-fired unglazed pots.
(additional fees for work that exceeds five pieces)
- Raku clay is highly recommended.
(available for purchase at Chester Springs Studio)
- Other clay bodies can be fired but may be prone to breakage.
- No large flat slabs
- Work must not be wider than 6 inches, no taller than 12 inches.
- Don't glaze work. We will glaze together as a group at the workshop.

Raku Workshop Provides:

- All Glazes
- Fuel
- Equipment
- Safety equipment and gloves

Proper Dress:

- Students must wear closed toe shoes, long pants.
- Long hair must be in a ponytail.
- Students must wear provided gloves at all time.
