Materials List

Materials to Bring:

- Bisqued pieces made of high fire, cone 10 clay
Each participant is allotted approx. 12x24x18 inches of space within the kiln.
Plates no larger than 12inches, and able to be wadded together and stacked in kiln.
Follow the Motto: “Bowl and plate, wait and wait. Tall and thin, it gets in.”
- Studio Clothing
- Firing Clothing (non flammable, 100% cotton)
- Comfortable closed toe shoes
- Camera
- Notebook/sketchbook
- Leather Gloves
- Eye Protection
- Dust Mask

- Glazing tools
- Decorating brushes
