

Supplies for Notan Watercolor

- Hardcover watercolor sketchpad (stays flat when open)
Or watercolor paper taped on a flat board with tape, washed and ready
- Small watercolor pad or 4x6 cuts of watercolor paper for testing color mixtures
- Paint Box (sectioned for colors) Cakes or tubes of paint
- Recommended Paint Colors: Cadmium Lemon, Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium, Cadmium Orange Deep, Cadmium Scarlet, Quinacridone Violet or Red, Magenta, Viridian Green, Permeant Green Light, Phthalo Green, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Lamp Black, White, Paynes Gray, Brown Pink, Burnt Umber, Raw Umber, Yellow Ochre, Raw Sienna, Burnt Sienna.
- Large tray for mixing colors
- Container of water w/ 2 cups plastic or metal (for cleaning brushes & one for dipping to paint)
- Brushes: Large and Small sizes. Mix of round, flat, filbert brushes, and large flat latex brush.
- Brush holder
- Mechanical or 2B pencil
- Kneaded Eraser
- Artist Composition Finder
- Color Wheel (pocket size)
- Safety razor blade
- Paper Towel roll
- 2 -4 oz. spray bottle
- Old toothbrush (for spattering)
- Sponges
- Note Pad and Pen, for taking notes
- Optional: Gum Arabic and White Mask Liquid

You may work indoors or outdoors (around studio location). If you prefer to work outdoors, bring a Travel Tripod easel for outdoor work. If you do not have a travel easel you may use the studio's aluminum easel. Bring a light-weight chair or stool and a pack to carry your supplies. If available, you may wish to use an umbrella to shade you and the paper when working. It is also handy to have a plastic bag for your trash.

If you are working indoors, bring reference photos of scenery that you admire. You may bring your easel, but the studio also has easels, tables and chairs for your use. There are also plastic containers for water.
