Gallery Consignment Show & Sale

We know a lot of folks used the time at home last year to renovate and update! This is your opportunity to look about your home, office, storage space, etc., for artwork, sculpture, and pottery that no longer compliments your space or you no longer have a place to display. The Recycled Art Show is also the perfect place to find a new piece for your home or office!

WHAT TYPES OF ARTWORK ACCEPTED

2-D - Antique and modern originals, prints, and posters. All artwork must be clean and in good condition, framed, and ready to hang with secure wire or hooks. We will not accept artwork that is faded, dirty, has watermarks, or cracked or chipped glass.

3-D - Antique and modern sculpture, ceramics and table art. No craft items. Pieces must be clean and in good condition with no chips or cracks.

This is a juried show, and we will only accept pieces that meet the above requirements. The jury holds the right to refuse any items at their discretion. If you are uncertain about the acceptability of any item, please send an image to Kmcclroy@yellowsprings.org. Artists may not sell the art they create; however, estates of artists are eligible. There is an entry limit of 10 items per person.

HOW TO ENTER ARTWORK IN THE SHOW

Fill out the attached jury application and return to Historic Yellow Springs by Friday, September 9th.

After your application is received, an email with a link to sign up for your jury time slot. Artwork will be juried by appointment only on September 13 & 14, 2022. Accepted pieces will be left at HYS to be tagged and hung for the show that opens on October 8 and runs through October 15.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Your decisions about price, descriptions, and sellers comments should be made before the jury. We will not negotiate lower bids with potential buyers during the show. Please consider this when setting your asking price. HYS is not qualified to appraise art and cannot be responsible for your pricing decisions and descriptive assertions. You must provide your own insurance coverage for all artwork and items entered in the show; Historic Yellow Springs is not responsible for loss or damage. Historic Yellow Springs' commission is 35 % on sales. Please be advised that your accepted inventory may be used on HYS social media outlets.

Unsold artwork must be picked up on Thursday, Oct. 20 • 10 am - 5 pm or Friday, Oct. 21 • 9 am - 4 pm. Any unsold pieces that are not picked up within 30 days after the end of the show become the property of HYS.

PREPARING ARTWORK FOR JURY

Please bring a copy of your inventory form to your jury appointment. Label each piece of artwork by folding a piece of masking tape in half over the hanging wire. Your last name and the item number corresponding with our inventory form need to be written clearly on the tape. If there is no wire, please loop a piece of string through the hook and attach the tape to the string. Use this method for 3-D works if the tape cannot be applied to the bottom of the piece.

FAQs

When is the show?

The Recycled Art Show opens on October 8 and runs through October 15. The galleries in the Lincoln building will be open 10 am - 4 pm daily.

How do I register to have artwork juried for the show?

Fill out the jury application and submit by Friday, September 9th. Email your application to Kmcclroy@yellowsprings.org or mail to Historic Yellow Springs, 1685 Art School Road, Chester Springs, PA 19425.

Is there a jury fee?

No, there is no fee to jury.

How do I make an appointment to jury?

After your application is received, an email with a link to sign up for a time slot will be sent. Click on the link and schedule your appointment. If you do not sign up, you will not be able to jury, please do not just show up.

What types of artwork are accepted?

2-D - Antique and modern originals, prints, and posters. All artwork must be clean and in good condition, framed, and ready to hang with secure wire or hooks. We will not accept artwork that is faded, dirty, has watermarks, or cracked or chipped glass.

3-D - Antique and modern sculpture, ceramics and table art. Pieces must be clean and in good condition with no chips or cracks. We are NOT accepting furniture, or craft items.

I am an artist, can I submit my original work?

No, artists may not sell the art they create; however, estates of artists are eligible.

Can I enter Yellow Springs Art Show posters?

We will only accept posters that we no longer have in stock at HYS. Poster we are accepting at this time are: 1986, 1991, 1996, 1999, 2010 and 2012.

How many pieces can I bring to the jury?

Bring up to 10 pieces to jury, items in a "set" or "group," count as one piece.

I have an item that I am not sure you will accept?

If you are uncertain about the acceptability of any item, send an image to kmcclroy@yellowsprings.org.

Where is the jury being held?

The jury will be in the Lincoln building at HYS, 1685 Art School Road, Chester Springs, PA. Parking is available across the street. Do not park in the handicap spaces unless you have the proper permit.

When do I drop off the artwork for the show?

All artwork accepted at the jury will stay at HYS to be added to the inventory, tagged and hung. You will not need to return to HYS to drop off.

When do I pick up unsold artwork?

The pick up days are Thursday, Oct. 20 • 10 am - 5 pm or Friday, Oct. 21 • 9 am - 4 pm. Any unsold pieces that are not picked up within 30 days after the end of the show become the property of HYS.

Do I need to provide my own insurance?

Yes, you must provide your own insurance coverage for all artwork and items entered in the show; Historic Yellow Springs is not responsible for loss or damage.

What percentage does HYS receive from sales?

Historic Yellow Springs' receives a 35% commission on sales.

Does HYS appraise the artwork?

NO, HYS is not qualified to appraise art and cannot be responsible for your pricing decisions and descriptive assertions.

Can I change pricing during the show?

No, HYS will not negotiate lower bids with potential buyers during the show. Please consider this when setting your asking price.

When do I need to submit my inventory form?

The inventory list included in this packet should be filled out before you come, and brought to the jury, and all pieces labeled by folding a piece of masking tape in half over the hanging wire. Your first and last name and the item number corresponding with the inventory form need to be written clearly on the tape. If there is no wire, please loop a piece of string through the hook and attach the tape to the string. Use this method for 3-D works if the tape cannot be applied to the bottom.

When will I receive my check from sold items?

Checks will be mailed 2-4 weeks after the show closes on October 15.
